In her new life, Ilse wonders if she and Michelle will survive the peace, and if their paths will ever cross again. Firestorm Survival is dedicated to people of every race whose lives have been caught up in the whirlwind of war and politics but who have survived against overwhelming odds. Many of us have been privileged to know people who lived through the tumultous times during and after the Second World War. Sadly their number grows fewer. Many never told their full story but years later, a sentence here, a memory there; snippets of conversation recalled still reverberate. Mercifully for some the mind blotted out that which was too painful, whilst for others it was disturbing to talk at length about the past. They are men and women we see in the street carrying their groceries home; the man with the white cane and empty coat sleeve sitting on the park bench. Some occurrences in the book did happen, but the characters and places are entirely fictitious. Firestorm Survival weaves together the fragments of several people's experiences to illustrate the fragility and strength of human endurance and sanity when powers beyond our control dictate our actions. Above all, it is a tribute to those who lost everything and survived to enjoy a return to more peaceful times, harbouring no bitterness against any race or country. Author, Joan Woolley, is the daughter of an RAF officer and Dresden firestorm survivor.
